Dear Friends,

Our last letter to you was just before Beverly and me traveled in January to Uganda for the week long Baptist conference. The conference had seven countries represented and was a tremendous success! We were invited by Pastor Jaluge John, this year's host pastor, to be the guest speakers. If you recall, this is the pastor that God has given me to work within the entire country of Uganda to reach the schools and youth prisons through our Prison Prevention ministry. We were able to share and even give details of the Prison Prevention ministry to the 600 pastors, their wives and church laymen in attendance. Before the conference started there were pastors from four countries that requested a meeting with me in private to discuss the school and juvenile prison ministry with them. I am thrilled to report that not only those four pastors are wanting to start the ministry through their churches, but also God has brought more pastors and churches for the expansion of our ministry in Uganda! We are now making plans for training churches in South Sudan, Congo, Rwanda, Tanzania as well as expanding the Uganda ministry in all four corners of the country! Absolutely tremendous opportunities to spread the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. The Lord has already shown me the first steps for starting this major expansion of the school and juvenile prison ministry in these areas. Please be in much prayer with me for these next steps and especially the supplies needed. We will be needing Bibles, New Testaments, John & Romans, gospel tracts, our Scripture coloring books and crayons and the God's Wisdom – Our Topics books that the Lord is using to reach and disciple so many souls of all ages. With this being said, we are now planning on sending a forty-foot shipping container sometime this summer with these materials. This will be ahead of our next visit where we will start trainings and expanding even into more remote areas to reach souls! We need much help with printing and shipping. Also, in the last letter we mentioned a knee surgery for Beverly after we got back from Uganda. She has now had her knee replacement. It was done the 30th of January. The surgery went well and her knee is doing very good. However, she has had a couple of complications and has had an allergic reaction to some medication. We had to seek medical help as she broke out with rash over much of her body. She was in misery for about a day and a half with her all her skin stinging and the rashes itching. She is now improving, but we could really use some prayer on this issue. It has been a tough season of time, but God is still good.

We are happy to report that the printing of the new Flip Charts has been successful. There have been very many delays, but we have finally printed and boxed the first Flip Charts. Beverly and me field tested them while we were in Uganda with the children. WOW! What a success! Just this month we have tested them in an elementary school and in an adult Sunday school class. These have a touch of God on them!! We will be printing for the above Uganda shipping container and these will also be used in the new countries as we teach and train these churches for the school and juvenile prison ministry reaching souls of the next generation.
