Thank you for remembering us and praying for us, there is no doubt in our hearts, many of the victories we have experienced are because of your prayers to God for us. Thank you, thank you.

Our Lord has been so kind in giving souls to be saved and we thank him for giving us fruit for our labor. In one of the men's unit at the Hamilton Co. Jail we have had six saved and in another men's service we have had another man (1) to be saved. As this sounds simple when preaching on the units and giving an open invitation for all that would come to repentance, all eyes are on the men who make professions of faith. To some praying and receiving Christ appears as weakness and some would seize this opportunity for any personal advantage or gain for themselves. We had more services but with no professions of faith. Also some of our services were cancelled, no fault of our part.

Gail and I enjoyed taking part in a women's prison revival at the Whitworth Correctional Institution of Hartwell, GA. The ladies were allowed visitation in the Faith/based dorm and in a lock down unit. In the services I enjoyed preaching to a near 100 women out for each services. At the close of the revival we left rejoicing over four (4) being saved. We are also hopeful of returning possibly in June.

At the close of February, we enjoyed the ministries annual Alabama Blitz. We were laboring in 10 prisons. We had one institution to close and surprisingly another institution who had told the ministry there was just no way, opened for us. The institution that opened was larger with more residents and our team was ready. ---Altogether, there was a total of 1469 residents in our worship services. There were 182 professions of faith. I was privileged to preach in the Montgomery Women Facility with four being saved. The next evening Gail and I together, led one young lady to Christ. Praise the Lord.

Let me close requesting your prayers for us. Please pray for traveling mercy, souls to be saved and for us to be a blessing to those we come in contact with. We have and will praying for you.
