The neurologists are confident she will recover but it will take time. Imagine using your thumb, but not being able to feel it. It is more of a nuisance right now. She is able to function, but can't feel things on her left side. Please pray for patience and complete healing for her. Thank you.

They have attended our Missionary Candidate School previously so they are familiar with procedures, etc. They need to be in country by the end of March so will not be in Missionary Candidate School this year. They agreed to come back in the future and attend the school and be interviewed to make everything official. Please pray they will get their visas quickly.

Kevin and Naomi announced that they are having another baby in September. They told us it is a little girl! We are excited for them. Please pray for a healthy pregnancy and an easy delivery when the time comes. Cyndie and I were able to go down for their Church's annual Missions Conference in March. The Church and School did an awesome job with flags, music and presentations. Dr. Scott Caudill did a great job preaching and the missionary presentations were great as well. It was good for us to be there and experience all of it. Kevin has been after us to come since he went there to teach so this was the year and we are glad we went. Missions Conferences never get old to me. We really appreciate Dr. Andy Bloom and Central Baptist Church for the great conference and opening their arms to Cyndie and I for the week.
